If I should take part in such a case, I agree to pay the U.S. Government for all damages, expenses, and costs it may incur as a result thereof. I understand and agree that I am assuming the risk of any personal injury or property damage to me that may result while taking part in the Flying Activity activities. These include such injuries or damage as may be caused by the negligence of the U.S. Government. I also understand and agree that I may be held liable for any damage or loss to the U.S. Government that is caused by my gross negligence, willful misconduct, or fraud.
