Route
Time Enroute (TO to LDG)
Destination

The Process (Cont)

•File with LMFSS **

•Weather Brief **

•NOTAMS, TFR's **

****Many options on these actions with LMFSS Automated System and Other providers**

The Process (Cont)

- <u>Fax</u> the Flight Plan to Redstone Flight Operations
- <u>Activate</u> the flight Plan Prior to Take-off
- <u>Cancel</u> the Flight Plan After Landing

Errors and Omissions

- Forget to Fax Copy to Operations
- Forget to or unable to activate prior to departure
- Inaccurate Data On plan
 - Route
 - Destination
 - Flight Time
 - Fuel on Board
 - Contact Information

How Important is It?

Search and Rescue (SAR) notification and <u>Time-To-Rescue</u> is greatly affected by:
Confirmation that aircraft is really missing!
Actual Route
How long the aircraft is airborne

- Was there a 406 MZ ELT Activated
- Was The Aircraft in Radar Contact

FAA Reference to USAF -SAR Statistics

Search and Rescue Average Response
 Instrument Flight Plan

 1.5 hours -Notification to initiate
 Search - Rescue Completed in 11.5
 hours

•VFR Flight Plan

• 4 hours to initiate Search - Rescue Completed in 18 hours

FAA Reference to USAF -SAR Statistics

Search and Rescue Average Response <u>No Flight Plan</u>

- 18 hours -Notification to initiate the search
- More than <u>60 Hours</u> to Rescue

• Exposure mortality is greater than 95% if rescue is longer that 51 hours

Accident Facts to Consider

- 4 of 5 General Aviation Accidents are initially survivable
- 75 % of Emergency landings result in
- injuries
- Head Injuries are common from impact on yoke and <u>unsecured flying objects</u>
- Injuries to arms/legs back from impact
- Survival odds are about 60% if rescue occurs within 8 hours.

Situational Awareness

- Be sure you activate your flight plan
- Make sure:
 - Your flight time duration accurate
 - Your Contact Information is correct
 - Your Route/Destination are accurate
 - Always use Flight Following
 - Carry at least basic survival kit
- •If emergency landing is, activate ELT

Minimum Survival Gear

- <u>Cell phone backup charger</u>
- Knife
- Space Blanket
- Medical Kit
- Flashlight
- Matches/Fire starter
